

Makes: 8 servings

Ingredients

1/2 cup popcorn kernels

1/4 cup canola oil

1/4 cup sugar

Instructions

- 1. Heat canola oil in a large pot over mediumhigh heat, along with 4 popcorn kernels.
- 2. Once all 4 kernels have popped, add rest of kernels and sugar, and stir quickly. Put lid on pot, then shake pot continuously over heat (to prevent burning) until popping slows and stops.
- 3. Remove from heat.

Hot Cocoa in a Jar

Ingredients

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup unsweetened cocoa
- 1 cup powdered milk
- 1/2 cup miniature marshmallows
- 1/2 cup chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup white chocolate chips
- 1-quart mason jar

Instructions

- 1. Using a clean quart jar, layer the ingredients starting with the unsweetened cocoa.
- 2. When ready to serve, store in an air-tight container
- 3. Add 1/3 cup of mix to one cup of hot water.
- 4. Makes 12 servings.
- 5. Attach an instruction tag to each jar.
